TECHNICAL BID**1) PREAMBLE OF TENDER**

The e-tender is for fixing an Insurer to cover the entire risk of the assets of TANCEM for the period of one year by following two cover systems viz., Technical Bid and Price Bid.

Tamil Nadu Cements Corporation Limited (herein after referred as TANCEM) is a Government of Tamil Nadu undertaking having its Corporate Office at 5th Floor, Aavin Illam, Nandanam, Chennai – 600 035 and having the following manufacturing units.

3.1 Clarifications in the Tender:

A prospective Bidder requiring any clarification in the Tender may address the Tender Inviting Authority by letter or by email, TANCEM will respond in writing to any request for clarification in the Tender.

3.2 Amendments to the Tender:

- a) TANCEM may amend the Tender Conditions upto 48 hours prior to the time fixed for submission of the tender.
- b) Also, amendment to the tender may be given in response to clarifications by prospective bidders solely at the discretion of TANCEM.
- c) Such amendments will be notified on <https://tntenders.gov.in>
- d) TANCEM at its discretion may or may not extend the due date and time for the submission of bids on account of amendments.
- e) All the Bidders must periodically browse <https://tntenders.gov.in> till the closing date of this Tender for any amendments or corrigendum issued in connection

with this Tender. TANCEM will not be responsible for any misinterpretation of the provisions of this tender document on account of the Bidders' failure to update the bid documents based on changes announced through the website.

3.5 Any offer made in response to this tender when accepted by TANCEM will constitute a contract between the parties.

3.6 Members of the Corporation not individually liable:

No Director or official or Employee of the Corporation shall, in any way, be personally bound or liable for his/her acts or obligations of the Corporation under the contract or answerable for any default or omission in the observance or performance of any acts, matters or things which are herein contained.

4) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

5) SUM INSURED VALUES

The Sum Insured values for the Issue of Policies are given in the price bid (BOQ).

6) COST OF BIDDING:

The Tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the tender and TANCEM will in no case be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the tendering process.

7) SUBMISSION OF TENDER:

The Tender consist of two stages viz., Technical Bid and Price Bid and should be up-loaded in the on-line portal. The first stage enables the Tender Inviting Authority to know whether the Tenderer is technically competent and capable of executing the order. Only those who qualify in the first stage would be eligible to take part in the second stage viz. Price Bid. The Price Bids of Tenderers who failed in the first stage will not be opened.

The bidder shall submit their bid only in online

7.1 Details to be furnished in the Technical Bid:

- a) General Information of the Bidder -Annexure-I
- b) Prequalification Checklist – Annexure – II
- c) Declaration as per Annexure II point no: 6 – Annexure – III
- d) Authorisation letter (Annexure-IV) from the Competent Authority of the Company to sign this Tender document. Documents received without such authorisation will not be considered for further processing.
- e) Certificate of Conformity – Annexure V
- f) The Bidder shall furnish as part of the bid, documents establishing the Bidders eligibility to bid and its qualifications to perform the Contract if their bid is accepted.
- g) All the required documents for Eligibility Criteria as per Clause. No.6 of the tender document and other documents wherever insisted in the Tender.
- h) The Bidder should have the financial and technical capability necessary to perform the contract.

The documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications shall be established to the satisfaction of TANCEM.

7.2 Details to be furnished in the Price Bid (BOQ):

Prices must be quoted only in the Price Bid (BOQ) and to be uploaded online.

7.3 Signing of Bids

The bids shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by the Bidder or a person or persons duly authorised to bind the Bidder to the Contract. **Bidders are requested to sign each and every page of the tender document including Annexure(s) attached thereto.**

7.4 Service of Notice:

Any notice hereunder may be served on the Successful Bidder by Registered Post at his last known address. Proof of issue of any such notice should be conclusive of the Successful Bidder having been duly informed.

8) OPENING OF e- TENDER:

- a) Tenders will be opened at the prescribed date and time in the presence of Tenderers or their representatives who choose to be present. The representatives of Tenderers must bring the authorisation letter from the bidder for attending the Tender opening. Not more than one representative for each Tenderer would be allowed to take part during the bid opening process.
- b) Technical bid would be opened first. Eligibility Criteria such as compliance with pre-qualification conditions will be checked. The supporting documents would be cross checked wherever required.
- c) Only the Technical bid will be opened on the due date.
- d) The date and time of opening the Price Bid will be intimated only to the qualified tenderer via online/e-mail/post.
- e) Tenders non-compliant with any of the tender terms will not be considered for the next stage i.e. for opening of the Price Bid

9) PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF BIDS

- a) The rate quoted should be valid for a minimum period for 90 days for acceptance from the due date. During the validity period, no tenderer is permitted to make any upward revision in the rate. Further no tenderer is permitted to withdraw their offer within the validity period of the tender or before finalisation of Tender.
- b) In exceptional circumstances, TANCEM may solicit the tenderer's consent for an extension of the period of validity totally not exceeding 180 days. The request and the responses there to shall be made in writing.

10) TENDER EVALUATION CRITERIA:

The evaluation of Tenders will be done by TANCEM as detailed below:

10.1) Technical Bid Evaluation:

Tenderers will be eligible for further processing only if they fulfil the following criteria:

- a) Enclosing the tender document duly signed by affixing seal in every page including amendments, if any.
- b) Compliance with the eligibility Criteria indicated in Sl. No 6 and submission of necessary proof.
- c) The Tenders, which do not conform to the Tender conditions or Tenders without adequate capabilities shall be rejected. The Eligible Bidders alone will be considered for further evaluation.
- d) If any of the tenderer is blacklisted by the Central Govt. or by the State Govt. to participate in the tender of Govt. Departments or Corporation, their tenders will not be considered for evaluation. In case after award of Tender, the successful bidder found to be blacklisted/banned, the contract will be terminated besides necessary action.

10.2) Price Bid Evaluation:**10.2.1 Opening of Price Bid:**

Bidders who are qualified in the Technical Bid alone will be called for Price Bid opening. The technically qualified Bidders alone will be informed of the date and time of opening of the Price Bid and their Price Bids alone will be opened on the informed date and time in the presence of the Bidders or their authorized representatives.

10.2.2 Price Bid Evaluation:

- a) Any arithmetic error is in totaling, the unit rate stands final and it will be considered for evaluation.
- b) The bidder must quote their price in the BOQ (excel) in all the respective fields in the excel – Price bid without fail. In case any price column left blank it will be treated as at zero cost and bidder cannot ask for any price alteration after the bid is opened.

10.2.3 Determination of the Lowest Evaluated Rate:

The lowest rate (**L1**) will be determined based on the total premium including GST quoted in the Price Bid (excel).

11) NEGOTIATION:

TANCEM reserves the right to negotiate with the Bidder whose offer is the lowest evaluated price for further reduction of rates. TANCEM also reserves the right to negotiate with other Bidders to match the negotiated L1 price strictly according to the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Rules 2000.

12) SPECIAL TERMS

In case any Successful Bidder fails to issue the policies in time, TANCEM reserves the right to place orders with the other successful Bidders.

TANCEM reserves the right to cancel/amend the tender at any point of time without assigning/stating the reasons thereof.

If the successful bidder fails to accept/issue the policies in time, then the said bidder will be blacklisted by the TIA and will be barred to participate for 5 years.

13) ACCEPTANCE OF TENDER:

- a) The final acceptance of the Tender is entirely vested with TANCEM, which reserves the right to accept or reject any or all of the Tenders in full or in part.
- b) After acceptance of the Tender, the Tenderer shall have no right to withdraw his Tender or claim higher price. TANCEM may also reject all the Tenders for reasons such as changes in the scope of work, lack of anticipated financial resources, court orders, accidents or calamities and other unforeseen circumstances.
- c) After acceptance of the Tender, TANCEM would issue orders only to the Successful Tenderer(s). TANCEM also reserves right to engage more than one Insurer under this Tender. Final decision in the proportion is entirely vested with TANCEM.
- d) The Contract period of 12 months will be counted from 01.07.2024.
- e) The invitation of Bids, the terms and conditions of Tender, Offer of the Tenderer and Letter of Acceptance issued by TANCEM along with any amendment issued to prior to finalization of Contract shall constitute a Contract between the Tenderer and TANCEM.

14) ACCEPTANCE OF ORDER

The order will be sent in duplicate and they shall return one copy along with enclosures duly signed and stamped within one working day in token of having received and accepted the order.

Insurance company should issue risk held letter within one day after the acceptance or the order.

Insurance company shall issue the respective policy copies within 7 working days after the acceptance of the order.

15) PAYMENT OF PREMIUM:

- a) TANCEM will remit the premium one day in advance prior to the commencement of policy i.e. from 01.07.2024.
- b) The Tenderer should not claim any upward price on account of any reason after issuance of order till payment of premium.

16) SCOPE OF COVER & GENERAL TERMS:

- a) The Successful Tenderer has to cover the entire risk by issuing Fire Policy, MBD Policy, Burglary Policy STFI, earth quake, Terrorism, Electronics Equipment Policy, CPM policy to cover for all the Assets, vehicles including Excavator, Tippers and Dumpers of TANCEM. Under the Fire Policy, premium should be quoted for the Standard fire and special perils policy with add on covers earthquake, terrorism risk and STFI for the assets.
- b) The Successful Tenderer has to issue original policy covering all the details within 10 days from the date of payment of premium. Policy copies of Vehicle Insurance should be issued on the date of expiry of existing policy period.
- c) Each claim should be settled on case to case basis within the reasonable time not more than 45 days from the date of request.
- d) If the Successful Bidder fails to act according to the Tender conditions or withdraws the offer after their Tender has been accepted, the contract will be cancelled and they will not be permitted to participate in future tender of the Corporation.

17) DISPUTES & ARBITRATION

- a) In respect of all the tender conditions, the decision of TANCEM shall be final and binding. All matters relating to any dispute which may arise during the execution of the contract shall be referred to the Managing Director, TANCEM for an amicable settlement. In the case of failure, the procedure in Clause 16 (b) shall be followed.
- b) In case of a dispute or difference arising between TANCEM and the Insurer, relating to any matter arising out of or connected with this contract, such disputes or differences shall be settled in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 2021 as amended from time to time. The dispute shall be referred to an Arbitrator, who shall be chosen by the contractor from a list of three arbitrators furnished by TANCEM. The decision of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties.
- c) Arbitration proceedings shall be held at Chennai and the language of the arbitration proceedings and that of all documents and communications between the parties shall be English.
- d) The provisions of Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 2021 as amended from time to time and the rules made there under and any statutory modification thereof shall be deemed to the part of this contract.

18) JURISDICTION

Subject to the above Clause, it is hereby agreed that Courts at Chennai City have jurisdiction to decide or adjudicate upon any dispute which may arise out of or be in connection with this contract agreement. The contract shall be governed by the Laws of Union of India/Government of Tamil Nadu in force.
